Dr. Jessica Kahler is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Sociology and Criminology & Law and affiliate faculty for the Archie Carr Center for Sea Turtle Research, Center for African Studies, the School for Natural Resources and the Environment, and the Tropical Conservation and Development Program at the University of Florida. She has consulted on various wildlife crime prevention projects and served in the US Peace Corps in the Republic of Vanuatu. Dr. Kahler's research focuses on wildlife guardianship, situational crime prevention, and the connections between climate change and wildlife crimes related to human-wildlife conflicts and community-based conservation. She works primarily within southern Africa and Southeast Asia and has published in Biological Conservation, Conservation Biology, Frontiers of Conservation Science, and two peer-edited books, to name a few. Her work has been funded by the National Science Foundation and the US Fish & Wildlife Service.
