

## **Tulio Kahn – Short Bio**

Kahn is a sociologist graduated from PUC in São Paulo, with a master's and doctorate in Political Science from the University of São Paulo, and consultant of the Fundação Estado Democrático. He was a consultant for the Secretariat of Public Security of São Paulo, working as a diretor of the Analysis and Planning Coordination from 2003 to 2011. He was Director of DECASP – Department of Cooperation and Coordination of Public Security Actions – of the Ministry of Justice at the end of the Fernando Henrique Cardoso government and Executive Secretary and Researcher of ILANUD - United Nations Latin American Institute for the Prevention of Crime and Treatment of Delinquent between 1999 and 2002. Consultant on several organizations such as the UNDP and IDB. Visiting Researcher at the Center for Brazilian Studies in Oxford in 2005, Visiting Scholar at CILAS, University of California, San Diego between 1996/97 and scholarship holder at Latin American and Caribbean Studies at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, 1995.
